According to the National Institute of Mental Health, feelings of emotional, mental and physical tension are common reactions to internal and external stressors.

Influential leaders cast inspiring visions and motivate their teams to achieve great things.

Law 4: Lead from Within

19 **Intro to law 4**
In a world of constant change and external influences, internal leadership skills are crucial.

20 **Prepare for long-term success**
Based on popular research done by the consulting firms McKinsey & Company and Accenture - work, workforces, and workplaces as you know them continue to change and evolve globally due to rapid tech, cultural, and societal disruption.

21 **Identify your leadership category**
It's often much easier to see and recognize the blind spots of others, especially in managerial positions.

22 **Foster psychological safety**
Research studies by Amy Edmondson & Google have shown that individuals who believe they won't be punished or humiliated for speaking up with their ideas, questions, concerns, or mistakes often perform better than those who don't.

23 **Cultivate inclusion and ethical leadership**
High productivity doesn't always equal a high sense of well-being, especially for those from historically marginalized backgrounds who don't believe they have the option to fail.
