We often hold our political beliefs very tightly and tend to avoid differing opinions.
- 13 Disagreement vs. harassment**
Political disagreement can become harassment, which has no place in any organization.
- 14 Agreeing to Disagree**
It's natural to want to persuade others to agree with your point of view, but this often creates unproductive conflict.
