13 **Empathy as a super-tool**
Your intellect may get you to the dance, but your emotional intelligence is what you bring to the dance floor.

14 **Humor as a bridge**
Tasteful and well timed humor can establish you as a genuine and likeable person -- two characteristics that are critical when networking!

15 **Invest in your speaking skills**
Enhancing your speaking skills is the best investment you can make in yourself, whether you are networking or not.

16 **Always add to the conversation**
There's a tactic in improv theater that says always "add to a conversation without taking away." After this lesson, you'll be able to empower and support others by encouraging and building upon their ideas.
